Perth Motor Show 2008 The West Australian Slot Cars Challenge

Terms and Conditions

Hours of operation

Races run hourly from 11-7pm on Tuesday 22nd, Wednesday 23rd, Thursday 24th and Saturday 26th and hourly from 1-7pm on Friday the 25th of April. They will then run hourly from 11-3pm on Sunday with the Championship Race taking place at 4pm. Each race has room for up to 6 contestants and with the exception of 4pm Sunday, there are two races every hour.

Format

To enter you are required to register your name at The West Australian stand at the Perth Motor Show where you will be put into a competition time slot on that day. Contestants will receive a sticker when they register – it is the responsibility of the contestant to be present with their sticker 5minutes before the race is due to start. Failure to do this will result in the contestant forfeiting their position. Races run hourly and placing is done on a 'first in, first served' basis.

Prize details

There are 6 daily prizes of a TomTom One 3rd Edition to be given away valued at \$399 to the fastest time each day. The Championship prize is a VMoto Montego Scooter valued at \$2990 which goes to the fastest time of the Championship Race.

General

You may only enter one race per day at the show (with the exception of the Championship Race on Sunday).

If you are under the age of 18, the prize must be collected by a parent/guardian on your behalf.

If you miss your set time, someone in the audience will replace you and you are able to register for another race that day (you are only allowed to be registered for one race at any given time).

The fastest contestant each day will be invited back to the show on Sunday for the Championship Race. One free entry to the show is given to the finalists for the Championship I Race on Sunday. If the contestant is unable to attend the finalist race, they are able to nominate a substitute. If a substitute cannot be found, the second fastest contestant from that day will be invited.

Winners of the daily prize will be notified in person at the end of that day. They are able to collect their prize in person after the Championship Race.

Winner of the final prize will be contacted by phone and published in The West Australian on Wednesday the 30th of April 2008.

Colin Hawkins from Checkered Flag Slot Cars will hold authority over the final rulings of the competition with the assistance of Electronic Timing Equipment.
